Confidentiality Agreement Women Business Owners' Roundtable

This Confidentiality Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into as of the date signed below by the undersigned participant (the "Participant") in the Women Business Owners' Roundtable (the "Roundtable") hosted by the Noblesville Chamber of Commerce - Women in Noblesville (WIN).

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure that all discussions, ideas, experiences, and materials shared within the Roundtable remain strictly confidential and are used solely for the intended purpose of the Roundtable and its members.

Terms of the Agreement

1. Confidential Information

Participant agrees that all information shared during the Roundtable sessions, including but not limited to personal experiences, business strategies, challenges, and ideas ("Confidential Information"), will be treated as strictly confidential.

2. Non-Disclosure

The Participant agrees not to disclose, share, or use any Confidential Information for any purpose outside the scope of the Roundtable without the express written consent of the disclosing party.

3. Exceptions

Confidential Information does not include information that:

- Is or becomes publicly known without breach of this Agreement;
- Was already in the Participant's possession without obligation of confidentiality; or
- Is required to be disclosed by law.

4. Duration of Obligation

The obligations under this Agreement shall remain in effect for the duration of the Roundtable and for a period of two (2) years following the conclusion of the Roundtable.

5. Acknowledgment

By signing this Agreement, the Participant acknowledges the importance of confidentiality to the success of the Roundtable and agrees to abide by these terms in good faith.
